CIRC: is the circumference of the tree measured at 4.5 feet above ground line

Height: is the total vertical height of the tree measured above ground line

Spread: is the average of the widest crown spread measurement and the crown spread measurement taken perpendicular to it

Total Points: circumference (in) + height (ft) + 1/4 average crown spread (ft)

National Champion: is a designation by *American Forests* as the largest known tree for that species in the United States
