

NOTES FOR 4-H AIR RIFLE PROGRAM

A young person must be enrolled in 4-H in order to participate in the Randolph County 4-H Shooting Sports Program.

Youth participants must be at least 8-18 years of age as of 9/1/10 in order to participate in the air rifle program.

Practices will be held indoors on Wednesdays starting December 8, 2010 in the Northeast Vendor Mall at the World Shooting & Recreational Complex in Sparta. The program will run through the end of February 2011.

Air rifles and paper targets will be provided.

Pellets will be provided for the practice session scheduled from December 2010 – February 2011. (Subject to change for future practice sessions.)

Participants must have safety glasses and ear plugs or ear muffs.

The fee each night to practice is \$3.00. The coach will collect the fee from each participant at each practice session and turn in practice fees to the World Shooting & Recreational Complex.

The following forms will need to be completed and turned in to the Extension Office prior to the first practice:

Youth Medical Form

Liability form

Survey

4-H Enrollment Form (if not already enrolled in a 4-H club)

Participants must pay a \$1.00 fee for insurance to the Extension Office prior to participating. This is a one time fee which provides additional insurance coverage for 4-H shooting sports participants.

In the event of inclement winter weather, families will receive a phone call notifying them about practice cancellations.

Participation in a hunter safety course is not a requirement to participate in the 4-H Shooting Sports Program.
